Construction Corner: We are moving along, and while I know we need the rain, it slows us down until we are fully enclosed. The steel erectors continue to work on putting up building two, which will house the new parish hall and kitchen, along with more storage for the Food Pantry, and another set of bathrooms (once we are able to financially complete them). We are now able to complete the parish offices and the gathering area (that will serve as a small gathering area for smaller events), and the covered drop off between the Discipleship Center and Church which are all a part of Building One. As announced last week at Mass, because of generous donors not from our parish, more pledges received, and non-pledge donations from parishioners, we are now able to complete these areas. Thank you to all of you! At this point, every donation matters. We are at a spot now, which we will not plan on finishing anymore of the building. Unless a major donation comes in, every pledge and donation we receive now will reduce the debt we take out on this building. If you have not turned in a pledge, keep in mind, 100% stays right here at St Rose. NONE is sent to the diocese as part of our United Catholic Stewardship. This will not last forever!

Community: Catholic Senior Adult Ministries will be hosting the Cradle of Catholicism Pilgrimage on September 21st. A Steward is a Christian Disciple (Fr. Jarrod Lies): "Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I shall give to the poor." (Lk 19:8) Stewardship follows from the call to discipleship. From the Latin *discipulus*, a disciple is a pupil, student, or learner. As the *Stewardship: A Disciple's Response* teaches, a disciple is "one who responds to Christ's call." Our life of stewardship is therefore intimately linked to our identity in the person of Jesus Christ. Stewardship, like discipleship, requires conversion. Thus, Zacchaeus, because of conversion to Jesus, became a steward. This is why the Diocese has adopted the phrase "discipleship-centered stewardship." Through conversion, disciples learn to make a sincere gift of themselves and their goods to others in an act of solidarity.
